## AMOS ANDERSON'S HEM

The Amos Anderson Hem museum is a must-visit for anyone interested in Finnish history, culture, and art. Amos Anderson (1878–1961) was the owner of Finland's largest Swedish-language newspaper, *Hufvudstadsbladet*, and a patron of the arts. The story has it that Amos Anderson had two sides to his personality: by day he was a determined businessman, and by night sensitive and sociable patron of the arts and culture.

## LIFE AND WORKS OF TOM OF FINLAND IN KIASMA

One of the highlights of Helsinki's cultural offerings in 2023 is the Tom of Finland exhibition at Kiasma, the Museum of Contemporary Art. Tom of Finland (born Touko Valio Laaksonen, 1920–1991) ranks among the most internationally acclaimed artists to come out of Finland. His drawings of happy gay men proudly enjoying their sexuality were revolutionary at a time when homosexuality was still considered a crime and fetishism classified as a disease. His art has been liberating and empowering for countless gay men and sexual minorities for decades.

### NÄYTTELTY ESITTELEE ALBERT EDELFELTIN KANSAINVÄLISENÄ VAIKUTTAJANA

Albert Edelfelt (1854–1905) oli kansainvälinen vaikuttaja, joka toimi tienraivaajana sekä yhteyksien luojana myöhemmille suomalaistaitelijoille erityisesti Pariisissa. Kattava näyttely tarkastelee Suomen tunnetuimpia ja rakastetuimpia kuuluvan taiteilijan koko uraa. Näyttely on esillä 17.9. saakka.

Edelfelt oli sosiaalisesti lahjakas ja ymmärsi verkostojen merkityksen jo uransa alkuvaiheessa. Hän puhui useita kielia ja seurusteli sujuvasti eri yhteiskuntaloukkiin kuuluvien henkilöiden kanssa. Edelfelt matkusteli Euroopassa ja Pohjoismaissa sekä asui suuren osan elämästäään Pariisissa.

Ranskassa hän tutustui moniin aikansa johtaviin taiteilijoihin, kulttuuri- ja tiede-elämään merkkihenkilöihin sekä taiteen keräilijöihin ja taidekauppiaisiin. Edelfeltin kollegoja ja ystäviä olivat muun muassa amerikkalainen John Singer Sargent, ranskalaiset Charles Baude ja Pascal Dagnan-Bouveret sekä ruotsalainen Anders Zorn. Edelfelt oli teknisesti erittäin taitava piirtäjä ja maalarii sekä omana aikanaan kansainvälisesti tunnettuin suomalaistaitelija.

Näyttely esittelee muotokuvia taiteilijan perheenjäsenistä, ajan merkkihenkilöistä ja taiteilijakollegoista. Esille saadaan maisemia ja näkymiä Pariisista sekä kuvauksia Edelfeltin matkoilta Etelä-Ranskasta, Italiasta ja Espanjasta. Hän maalasi kotoisia maisemia Porvoossa ja huvilallaan Haikossa sekä Helsingissä. Mukana ovat monet rakastetut teokset, joita pidetään suomalaisten kansallisaarteina, kuten Leikkiviä poikia rannalla (1884), Pariisin Luxembourg-puiston puistossa (1887), Ruokolahden eukkoja Kirkonmäellä (1887) ja Lapsen ruumissaatto (1879).

Näytellyssä nähdään myös useita teoksia, joita ei ole aikaisemmin esitellyt Suomessa. Kansallisgallerian kokoelmiin kuuluvien teosten lisäksi lainoja saadaan julkisista ja yksityisistä kokoelmista sekä Suomesta että ulkomailta.

### THE EXHIBITION PRESENTS ALBERT EDELFELT AS AN INTERNATIONAL INFLUENCE

Albert Edelfelt (1854–1905) was an international influencer who acted as a pioneer and creator of connections for later Finnish artists, especially in Paris. The comprehensive exhibition examines the entire career of one of Finland's best-known and most loved artists. The exhibition is on display until September 17.

Edelfelt was socially gifted and understood the importance of networks early in his career. He spoke several languages and socialized fluently with people from different social classes. Edelfelt traveled in Europe and the Nordic countries and lived a large part of his life in Paris.

In France, he got to know many of the leading artists of his time, prominent figures in the cultural and scientific life, as well as art collectors and art dealers. Edelfelt's colleagues and friends included the American John Singer Sargent, the French Charles Baude and Pascal Dagnan-Bouveret, and the Swedish Anders Zorn. Edelfelt was a technically very skilled draftsman and painter and the most internationally known Finnish artist of his time.

The exhibition presents portraits of the artist's family members, significant figures of the time and artist colleagues. Landscapes and views from Paris and descriptions from Edelfelt's travels in the south of France, Italy and Spain will be displayed. He painted home landscapes in Porvoo and his villa in Haikko and Helsinki. Included are many beloved works that are considered Finnish national treasures, such as Playing Boys on the Beach (1884), in the Luxembourg Park in Paris (1887), Ruokolahti Eukkoni on Kirkonmäki (1887) and Lapsen ruumissaatto (1879).

The exhibition also features several works that have not been presented in Finland before. In addition to works belonging to the collections of the National Gallery, loans are received from public and private collections both in Finland and abroad.

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# NIGHTLIFE



## HELSINKI - PROBABLY THE BEST CITY TO PARTY!

Helsingin yöelämä painottuu voimakkaasti viikonloppuihin, mutta tuolloin menoaa siten riittääkin koko viikon edestä! Arkisin ihmisiä houkuttelevat pienemmät baarit, pubit ja kesäisin terassit. Helsingin yöelämän erikoisuutena ovat ns. open stage karaokepaikat, jotka ovat niin paikallisten kuin ulkomaalaisten vieraiden suosiossa myös viikolla, näistä suosituimmat ovat Wallis' ja Erottaja.

Aivan keskustasta löytyvät suuret yökerhot, kuten Apollo Live Club, Maxine, Baarikärpänen & Hercules, Milli Klubi, Teatteri, Mummotunneli (vain kesäisin) & Kaarle XII. Keskustasta kävelymatkan päästä, Katajanokalla, on Helsingin oma "Nyhavn", jossa on menoaa myös arkiiltoina. Alue alkoi rakentua Kimi Räikkösen perustaman Wallis'-nimisen karaokebaarin ympärille, jossa menoaa on nykyään 365 päivänä vuodessa.

The nightlife in Helsinki is heavily focused on weekends, but there's plenty of action to last the whole week! On weekdays, people are drawn to smaller bars, pubs, and outdoor terraces during the summer. A unique feature of Helsinki's nightlife is the so-called "open stage karaoke" venues, which are popular among both locals and foreign visitors throughout the week. The most popular ones are Wallis' and Erottaja.

In the city center, you can find large nightclubs such as Apollo Live Club, Maxine, Baarikärpänen & Hercules, Milli Klubi, Teatteri, Mummotunneli (only in the summer), and Kaarle XII. Within walking distance from the city center, in Katajanokka, there is Helsinki's own "Nyhavn," where there's also a lively atmosphere on weekdays. The area began to develop around a karaoke bar called Wallis, founded by F1 star Kimi Räikkönen, and now it's active all year round.

Kolmas yöelämän keskittymä taas on hieman kauempana (~3 km) keskustasta, eli Kalliossa. Vielä 20 vuotta sitten alue oli tunnettu ainoastaan halvasta oluesta. Tänä päivänä alueella on lukuisia trendikkäitä baareja ja menomestojia, joissa voi bongata aina pääministeristä maamme ykkösohjelmiin tullessa sulassa sovussa.

Helsingin yöelämä on hyvin rentoa ja pukeutumisissään nöti miltillisä. Suurempien yökerhoihin kannattaa varata pöytä, jos haluat välttää jonot. Yökerhoihin maksaa tyyppillisesti 10–20 euroa sisään ja pöytävaraukset ovat useammin minimikulutuksella 150–500 euroa/iltta. Vaikka suomalaiset ovat ujoja arkisin, niin viikonloppuisin helsinkiläiset muuttuvat yöelämässä sosiaalisimmaksi, eikä edes internet ole pystynyt sivuuttamaan kaupungin yökerhojen suosiota seurauksissa.

Hiukan varttuneemmat ihmiset suosivat Apollo Live Clubia, Mummotunnelia, Rymy Eetua ja Teatteria. Nuorison suosiossa ovat Heidi's Bier Bar, Kaivo Huone ja Tavastia. Taas erikoisin yhdistelmä on ehdottomat Baarikärpänen & Hercules, jossa saman katon alla on nuorten suosima disco ja Stadin suosituin gay-yökerho.


Suurimmassa osassa yökerhoja on erittäin laaja drinkkivalikoima, jota kannattaa testata. Suomalaiset baarimestarit ovat menestyneet viime aikoina kansainvälisissä kisoissa ja viimeisen 10 vuoden ajalta meillä on useampikin maailmanmestari cocktail-puolelta. Tasoja voi testata jo Helsinki-Vantaalla vuolaasti kehutussa Runway Baarissa, jossa muuten on pääkaupunkiseudun parhaat after workit perjantai-ilta-päivisin ja kerran kuussa varmasti maailman ainoat lentokenttäbileet!

Another nightlife hub is a bit further away (~3 km) from the city center, in Kallio. Just 20 years ago, the area was known only for cheap beer. Today, it hosts numerous trendy bars and venues where you can spot everyone from the Prime Minister to the country's top artists partying in harmony.

Helsinki's nightlife is very relaxed, and the dress code rules are moderate. If you want to avoid queues, it's advisable to reserve a table at the larger nightclubs. The typical entrance fee to nightclubs is around 10–20 euros, and table reservations often have a minimum consumption requirement of 150–500 euros per evening. Although Finns are shy during weekdays, on weekends, Helsinki residents become more social in the nightlife scene, and even the internet hasn't been able to surpass the popularity of the city's nightclubs for socializing.

Slightly older people prefer Apollo Live Club, Mummotunneli, Rymy Eetu, and Teatteri. The favorites among the younger crowd are Heidi's Bier Bar, Kaivo Huone, and Tavastia. However, the most unique combination is definitely Baarikärpänen & Hercules, where under the same roof, you'll find a disco favored by the youth and the most popular gay nightclub in Helsinki.

Most nightclubs offer an extensive selection of drinks that are worth trying. Finnish bartenders have recently succeeded in international competitions, and in the past 10 years, we have had several world champions in the field of cocktails. You can test their skills at the highly praised Runway Bar at Helsinki-Vantaa Airport, where they also host the best after-work events in the metropolitan area on Friday afternoons and, once a month, the world's only airport party!



# HEADING TO THE HEART OF NATURE

*Summer is the golden time for outdoor excursions. Helsinki is full of fascinating excursion destinations. Here, we present four places where you can go for a picnic, for example.*

## Kasakallio

Kasakallio, also known as Kasaberget, is an excellent nature excursion destination. It is a forested area with paths crisscrossing in various directions. The area is popular for mushroom picking and berry foraging. Kasakallio is located in eastern Helsinki, near the border of Sipoo. The area used to belong to Vantaa but was incorporated into Helsinki in 2009.

The heart of the Kasakallio area is a tall rock formation that can be climbed from multiple directions. From Kasakallio, there are magnificent views, and it has been sometimes referred to as "Helsinki's Coin." At the top of Kasakallio, there is a Bronze Age burial mound.

It also served as an optical telegraph during the Crimean War in the 1850s.

Along the trails, you can find erratic boulders, small gorges, and cliffs. The landscape is adorned with twisted pines and gnarled Scots pines. While wandering through the forest, you can contemplate how the sea once surged at the foot of the rock just over a thousand years ago.

A good place to start your excursion is the parking lot along Talosaarentie, from where paths lead into the forest. You can also begin your journey from the vicinity of Viikkulantie. There are no guided routes in the area.

## Läntinen Pukkisaari

Many have visited Seurasaari, but few have been to Läntinen Pukkisaari (Western Pukkisaari). From the middle of the Seurasaari bridge, there is a trail that continues as a boardwalk and leads to Läntinen Pukkisaari. Sommelo ry has built an Iron Age village on this small island. Nowhere else in Helsinki can you experience the atmosphere of the Iron Age in the same way.

Sommelo ry was founded in the 1990s, and at that time, a group of enthusiasts began building the village on the island. In the courtyard of the ancient village, there is a collection of buildings designed to resemble Iron Age structures as closely as possible. There is a forge, a granary, a cooking hut, and a central hearth building. Visitors can enjoy their packed lunches by the shore.

## Kallvik

Kallahti, also known as Kallvik, is located in Vuosaari and is a popular outdoor area. It features a couple of kilometers long peninsula. The beginning of Kallahti Peninsula is a narrow ridge adorned with stunning villas, with the open sea on both sides. The terrain consists mainly of pine forest.

At the end of the peninsula, there is a public beach with summer cafes. The beach has a shallow shoreline, allowing you to wade quite far into the water. The depth reaches ankle level about a hundred meters from the shore.

After the beach, you enter a nature reserve, which is the most beautiful part of the area. It is advisable to stay on boardwalks and trails in order to avoid damaging the valuable nature unnecessarily.

## Tullisaari

Despite its name, Tullisaari is not actually an island but connected to the mainland. It is a charming and beautiful park area located in Laajasalo, offering an intriguing history. You can take a walking trip there to enjoy nature and the sea. Tullisaari has been called Helsinki's Montrepos for a good reason.

The most striking building on Tullisaari is Aino Ackté's villa, which was completed in 1877 based on the designs of architect Theodor Decker. Soprano Aino Ackté used the villa as her summer residence from 1904 to 1944. Next to it, there is an old limestone quarry.

Within the Tullisaari park, there are three trees protected as natural monuments. A bifurcated lime tree reaches over 20 meters in height, while another similar one is only a few meters shorter. The circumference of an oak tree is nearly four meters. All of them were protected in 1956.

From Tullisaari park, you can access the small deserted island called Killingholma via a narrow bridge.

## Kasakallio

Kasakallio eli Kasaberget on erinomainen luontoretkikohde. Se on metsäinen alue, jossa risteilee polkuja moneen suuntaan. Alue on suosittua siestys- ja marjastusseutua. Kasakallio sijaitsee aivan itäisessä Helsingissä, lähellä Sipoon rajaa. Alue kuului ennen Vantaalle, mutta liitettiin osaksi Helsinkiä vuonna 2009.

Kasakallion alueen sydän on korkea kallio, jonne pääsee kiipeämään monesta suunnasta. Kasakalliolta on komeat näkymät ja sitä on joskus kutsuttu Helsingin Koliksi.

Kasakallion huipulla on pronssikautinen hauta. Siellä on toiminut myös optinen lennätin Krimin sodan aikana 1850-luvulla. Polkujen varsilla on siirtolohkareita, pieniä rotkoja ja jyrkänteitä. Maisemaa värittää kelot ja käppyrämänyt. Metsässä samoillessa voi miettiä, miten meri velloi kallion juurella vielä hieman toistatuhatta vuotta sitten. Hyvä paikka aloittaa retki on esimerkiksi Talosaarentien varrella oleva parkkipaikka, josta lähee polkuja metsään. Myös Viikkulantien varrelta voi aloittaa retken. Opastettuja reittejä alueella ei ole.

## Läntinen Pukkisaari

Moni on käynyt Seurasaarella, mutta harva Läntisessä Pukkisaareessa. Keskeltä Seurasaaren siltaa lähtee polku, joka jatkuu pitkospuin ja päättyy Läntiseen Pukkisaareen. Sommelo ry on rakentanut pieneen saareen rautakautisen kylän. Missään muulla Helsingissä ei voi aistia rautakauden tunnelmaa samalla tavalla. Sommelo ry on perustettu 1990-luvulla ja silloin ryhmä aktiiveja ryhtyi rakentamaan saareen kylää. Muinaiskylän pihapiirissä on joukko rakennuksia, jotka muistuttavat mahdollisimman paljon rautakautisia rakennelmia. On pajaa, aittaa, keittokotaa ja keskiliemiesimajaa. Rannalla voi nauttia evältää.

## Kallvik

Vuosaarella sijaitseva Kallahti tunnetaan myös nimellä Kallvik. Siellä on parin kilometrin pituinen niemi, joka on suosittua ulkoiluseutua. Kallahdenniemen alkuosa on kapeaa harjua, jossa on upeita huiviloita. Harjun molemmilla puolilla velloo avomeri. Maasto on pääosin mäntymetsää.

Niemen loppupäässä on kaupungin yleinen uimaranta kesäkahviloineen. Ranta on matala ja siellä pääsee kahlaamaan vaikka kuinka pitkälle. Sadan metrin päässä vettä on nilkkoihin saakka.

Uimarannan jälkeen alkaa luonnonsuojelualue, joka on alueen upeinta seutua. Siellä kannattaa pysyä pitkospuilla ja poluilla, jottei turhaan tuhoa arvokasta luontoa.

## Tullisaari

Nimestään huolimatta Tullisaari ei ole saari, vaan kiinni mantereessa. Tullisaari on Laajasalossa sijaitseva hurmaavan kaunis puistoalue, jolla on jännittävä historialla. Sinne voi lähteä kävelyretkelle nauttimaan luonnosta ja merestä. Tullisaarta on kutsuttu Helsingin Montrepos'ksi - eikä turhaan.

Tullisaaren näyttävin rakennus on Aino Ackté huivila, joka on valmistunut vuonna 1877 arkkitehti Theodor Deckerin suunnitelmienvohjalta. Sopraano Aino Ackté käytti huivilaa kesäpaikkanaan vuosina 1904-1944. Sen vieressä on vanha kalkkikivilouhos.

Tullisaaren puistossa on peräti kolme puuta rauhoitettu luonnonmuistomerkinä. Kaksihaarainen metsälehmus kohoa yli 20 metriin. Toinen vastaava jäää vain muutamaa metriä matalammaksi. Tammen ympäryysmitta on lähes neljä metriä. Ne kaikki on rauhoitettu vuonna 1956.




